

## **COFFEE CONNECTION**

# **Kirk Cottage Courtyard**

Thank you for volunteering to host coffee connection between services. Because of you, members, regular attenders, and visitors—including children—attending both morning worship services are given the opportunity to mingle in a relaxed environment, sip freshly brewed coffee, and connect with friends or meet new ones. Thank you for making this a reality!

**Location:** Kirk Cottage Courtyard

<u>Time:</u> Be prepared to start service at 10:00 a.m. Begin clean-up at 10:30 a.m.

All supplies needed are on the counters in the Kirk Cottage kitchen.

Kirk Cottage doors will be unlocked when you arrive. They may remain unlocked when you leave.

#### **All Things Doughnut Holes:**

- O Available for pick-up at Clayton's Sidewalk Pick Up Window as early as 8:30 a.m.
  - Do not stand in line to order. Use the Pick Up Window to the right.
- They are prepaid; held under "Graham Memorial."
- o Divide between two large bowls and center bowls on the non-coffee table.
  - Put a pair of tongs next to each bowl
  - Do not place bowls on tables until adults from 9:00 a.m. service arrive.
  - Put out half. When empty, replace with the rest of the doughnut holes.

### All Things Coffee: Takes ~45 minutes to brew regular; ~25 minutes for decaf.

- o Fill regular urn with water to 40 cups line; use 2 ½ cups of regular coffee grounds.
- o Fill **decaffeinated** urn with water to 20 cups line; use 1 ½ cups of decaf grounds.
- Plug in urns and red light on side of urn will come on indicating brewing has begun. Amber light will
  come on when brewing is complete.
- o Put wooden, brown striped box at one end of table; orange striped at the other
- o Put orange "Decaf" & brown "Regular" name tents in front of appropriate urn.
- o Before placing urns on table, remove and wash filter baskets and percolator tubes
  - Put coffee grounds in waste basket; as in, do not put down sink drain.
- Place urns so decaf is dispensed from Kirk House side of table and regular is dispensed from Kirk Cottage side of table.
- o Center the cups, sugars, creamers, stirrers and napkins on table that has the coffee.
- O Tables: Two, foldable 6' tables located along the wall as you walk in from the Courtyard.
- o Casual; as in, no tablecloths.

## Waste bins: Three, black, no-lids

- o Put one at the center of each side of the coffee (by the coffee "condiments").
- o Put one at the C Street end of the doughnut hole table.

#### Water: Two, pitchers

o Place on table with cups; refill as needed.

#### Clean-Up:

- o Wipe off tables.
- o Return tables and waste baskets. Empty baskets in dumpster. Replace liners.
- o Wash, dry, and return bowls and urns to counter.
- o Return unused coffee supplies and water pitches to counter.
